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**Brent Barrett, tenor**

Most recently seen on Broadway reprising his role as Billy Flynn in the Tony Award-winning hit *Chicago-The Musical*, for which he received a Los Angeles Drama Critics Award, Brent Barrett received an Olivier Award nomination for his starring role in the London premiere of the Tony Award-winning Broadway revival of *Kiss Me, Kate* and made his debut as the Phantom in Andrew Lloyd Webber's *Phantom-The Vegas Spectacular*. Other Broadway credits include *West Side Story*, *Annie Get Your Gun* (opposite Reba McEntire), *Dance a Little Closer* and *Grand Hotel*. Additional New York performances include the Broadway revival of *Candide*, New York City Opera's *Brigadoon* and Off-Broadway roles in *Closer Than Ever*, *March of the Falsettos*, *The Death of Von Richthofen*, *The Time Of Cuckoo* and a musical version of *Portrait of Jenny*. Barrett received critical acclaim when he performed as a soloist at Carnegie Hall, The Royal Albert Hall and Royal Festival Hall in London and with the Berlin Philharmonic, Boston Pops, Minnesota Opera, Opera Pacific, Michigan Opera, Birmingham Symphony and Liceu Opera House in Barcelona. On television and in film Barrett was featured in *The Producers*, *Hercules*, *Longtime Companion*, *All My Children*, *Another World* and *Guiding Light*. He is a founding member and producer of The Broadway Tenors.



**Brian Lane Green, tenor**

Tony Award nominee for Best Actor in a Musical for his performance as Spacepunk in *Starmites*, Brian Lane Green made his Broadway debut as Huck Finn in *Big River*. He went on to star in the first national tour of that show and also in the national tour of Andrew Lloyd Webber's *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*. He also appeared on Broadway as Jo Jo in the Cy Coleman musical *The Life*. Green's regional theater credits include *West Side Story*, *The Pirates of Penzance*, *Pippin*, *Camelot*, *La Cage Aux Folles*, *1776* and *Julius Caesar*, in which he played Marc Antony. On television, Green has guest starred on numerous primetime shows, including *Sabrina the Teenage Witch*, *Murder, She Wrote*, *Matlock*, *Hotel* and *Highway to Heaven*. Day-time audiences know him as Alan Brand on *Days of Our Lives*, Sam Fowler on *Another World* and Brian Bodin on *All My Children*.



**Aaron Lazar, tenor**

Aaron Lazar is currently starring in Stephen Sondheim's Broadway revival of *A Little Night Music* opposite Catherine Zeta-Jones and Angela Lansbury. Broadway credits include *Impressionism*, *A Tale of Two Cities*, the revival of *Les Miserables* (Drama Desk nomination), *A Light in the Piazza*, *Oklahoma!* and *Phantom of the Opera*. Lazar co-starred with Reba McEntire and Brian Stokes Mitchell in the Hollywood Bowl production of *South Pacific*. As a soloist, he has worked with the New York Pops at Carnegie Hall, the Boston Pops conducted by Keith Lockhart, the
