

**Important information about Parking/Traffic
at the Cary Arts Center for Saturday, December 14**

On **Saturday, December 14, 2-4pm**, the Cary Jaycees will host the annual Cary Christmas parade in Downtown Cary. This will have a major impact on parking at the Cary Arts Center. The Town is making special accommodations to manage traffic and parking around the arts center on this exciting day.

What you need to know:

PARKING OPTIONS: For those who will arrive and leave the arts center before 1 p.m.

- 1) Parking Lots 2 & 3 (see map on the backside) will be blocked off from 8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Only folks attending classes or seeking services at the Cary Arts Center will be allowed to park in these lots. We will have volunteers at Parking Lots 2 & 3. You will simply be asked to identify why you are here to ensure the lots remain available for users of the Cary Arts Center.
- 2) Another option for you is to park in the lot in front of Cary Elementary, off of Kildaire Farm Road; this parking lot will not be blocked off.

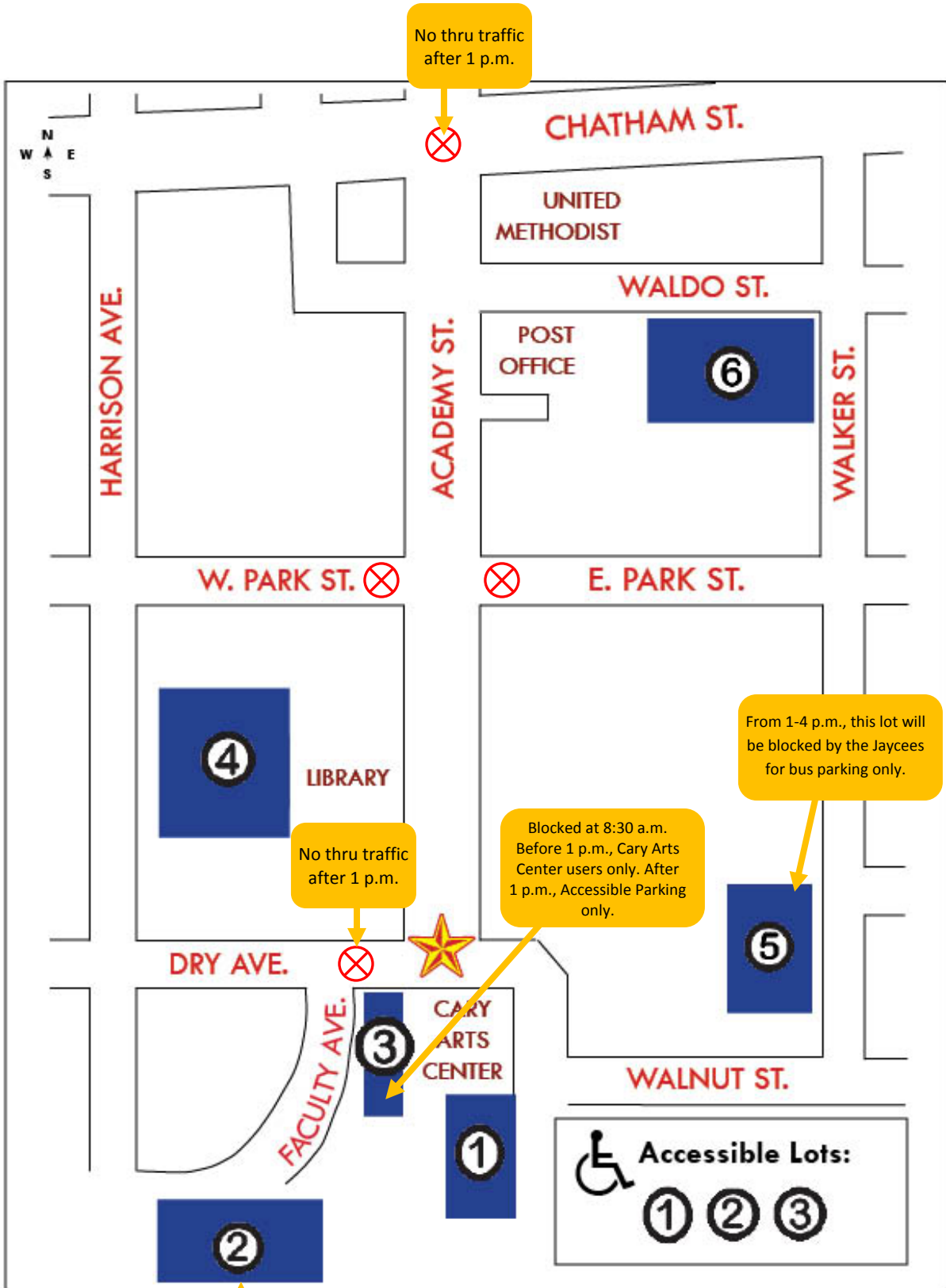
NOTE: Roads for the parade route will begin being blocked around 12:30 p.m. This will affect Academy Street from the arts center up to Chatham Street and Dry Avenue (directly in front of the arts center) from Harrison to Walnut Street. You will not want to be parked on Academy Street or at the library during this time.

PARKING OPTIONS: For those arriving after 1 p.m.

- 1) Parking & Shuttle Service
The Town will provide a free shuttle services between the Cary Arts Center and the Town Hall parking deck. Two shuttles will run on a continuous loop between 1-6 p.m. to accommodate patrons attending both the parade and activities at the arts center. Look for the signs that indicate where the shuttles drop off and pickup points are at Town Hall and the arts center. At Town Hall, the pick up/drop off will be located on Wilkinson Avenue, directly beside the entrance to the Herb Young parking lot. At the Cary Arts Center, the pickup/drop off will be located directly beside Parking Lot 3.
- 2) Parking Lot 2 will be available to users of the Cary Arts Center only. It will fill quickly. Therefore, we highly encourage you to park at Town Hall and ride the shuttle to the arts center. The shuttle will drop you off in Parking Lot 3, right beside the arts center.
- 3) Parking Lot 3 will be reserved for accessible parking only, in addition to serving as the shuttle pick up/drop off point. It too will fill quickly.
- 4) Parking Lot 5 will be available to anyone to use; however, we anticipate the parade traffic taking over this lot entirely.
- 5) For our fit folks, another option would be to park at the Town Hall parking deck, and walk down Academy Street, taking in the parade (if it is between 2-4 p.m.) It is only a short 0.5 mile walk!

Getting to the Cary Arts Center

For those trying to get to the arts center between 12:30-4:30 p.m.: avoid roads East of Academy Street and South of Chatham Street. Look for detour signs. *Take advantage of the shuttle service (see #1 above, Parking & Shuttle Service).*
